On the other hand, continuance of inefficient Teacher and his/ her equation with sincere and dedicated ones create a sense of dissatisfaction for the latter and for a Cadet who has to endure the inefficient Teacher will not only mar his/ her life/ career, but also cannot be compensated in any form in their entire life. Similarly, the Medical Officer and Counsellor will also play an important role in Cadet's growth and development and without his/ her active participation and involvement the Cadet could not be achieved his/ her dream and aim for which he/ she joined Vidya Bharati Gujarat Pradesh managed Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Military Academy.
- The scheme to establish Sainik Schools was introduced in 1961 with the primary aim of preparing Cadets academically, physically and mentally for entry into the National Defence Academy, Indian Naval Academy and other regular Armed Forces of the country. Ministry of Defence (MoD) has approved setting up of 42 new Sainik Schools, in partnership with NGOs/private schools/State Governments. These schools will be set up in the initial round of the Government's initiative of setting up of 100 new Sainik schools across the country in partnership mode. They will be distinct from the existing Sainik Schools. Vidya Bharati Gujarat Pradesh managed Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Military Academy started from 01 July 2023. The school is imparting full time CBSE quality residential education viz Academics, Sports and Games, Co-Curricular, Co-Scholastic, Cultural, Social, Scientific and Adventurous Activities, Marathons, PT Display, Marshal Arts, Yoga, Drill, NCC, Parades, Excursions, Expeditions, Educational Visits, Study Tours, Motivational Talks, Public Speaking, Career Guidance, NDA Coaching, Quizzes, Olympiads, Discipline, Socially Useful Productive Works and inculcating sound character, integrity, principles, values, ethos, etiquettes, comradery, leadership, workmanship, patriotism, Officer Like Qualities among the Cadets and making them responsible citizens. The present inhouse hosteller Cadet strength is 137 including 48 girls from Class VI to VIII. In future School will raise up to CI - XII.
- 5. The school is a full-time residential institution consisting Class VI to Class VIII and the nature of work and working hours are according to the rules and regulations of Sainik Schools Society, New Delhi. The school is not a State Govt or Central Govt institution. It is purely Self Finance School managed by Vidya Bharati Gujarat Pradesh (NGO) working under Sainik Schools Society and the governing rules and regulations of Sainik Schools Society are final in all respects for all purposes at all times on all occasions, vide Rules and Regulations -2022 for New Sainik Schools.
- 6. Indian nationals can only apply and all candidates have to produce their citizens in the form of a valid Aadhar Card or Voter Identity Card or Driving Licence or Passport

or NRC or any other valid document issued by the competent authority of India with residential address and photo.

- 7. The appointment is non-transferrable. The selected staff will be on probation for one year extendable to two years. On successful completion of probation period the candidate will be considered for confirmation from the date of initial appointment for the said post.
- 8. On scrutiny and screening of applications the date and time of Written Examination, Demonstration, Interview, Results etc will be communicated through telephone. The Call Letter or any other kind of communication will be intimated through Post/ Courier/E-Mail/ WhatsApp/ SMS. No Public Notice/ Media Advertisements/ Electronic Means/ Digital Platforms/ Mobile Applications/ Social Media Accounts/ Satellite Television Chanels/ AIR directly or indirectly or in person etc and no Public Notice will be published in any newspaper. - 9. The school reserves right under administrative & unexpected reasons at any point of time to:

the NOC must contain all requisite details viz Number, Rank and Name, Date of Enrolment and Discharge/ Retirement, Medical Category, Character, Amount of Service Pension, Experience, Service Rendered and Commendations if any etc.

The essential and desirable educational and other qualifications including age will be reckoned till the last date to receive the application only i.e., <u>26 Mar 2025</u> (i.e., last/ closing date for receipt of applications). Mere fulfilment of essential and desirable educational and other qualifications including age does not entitle any candidate to receive intimation for recruitment and the decision of Management of Vidya Bharati Gujarat Pradesh managed Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Military Academy is final.
- 18. The application should be as per prescribed format uploaded in the school website and QR code given and incomplete applications will not be scrutinised and screened and no call letter will be issued to them and the same will not be intimated in any form.

- 21. A candidate's admission to Written Examination (Online/Offline), Demonstration, Interview, Results etc and subsequent process if any is strictly
